

Day 2 – 26. June Hylkedal

Driving directions

Entry to the arena is from Holbergsvej 50, 6000 Kolding, GPS-koordinater 55.478519, 9.444852 (WGS84 decimal).

The following services are available at the arena:

- Event Office. Opens at 11:00.
- Kiosk.
- First aid
- Toilets. Toilets are also available at the two starts.

Changing rooms with showers are available near the arena. Follow the signs.

Distances and marking

- Parking – arena, 0 – 250 meter.
- Arena – start 1, app. 2400 meter or 30 min walk. Marked by pink flags.
- Arena – start 2, app. 1300 meter or 15 min walk. Marked by light green flags.

Please be aware that there are two starts. The starts are indicated in the overview mentioned above. The classes are not distributed the same way on all stages, so please check which start to go to – every day.

Race map

Hylkedal & Seest Grusgrav, scale 1:7.500 and 1:4.00. Contour interval 2,5 meter.

Classes starting from Start 1, are running on a 1:7.500 map to begin with, then switch to 1:4.000 by turning the map and then end with 1:7.500, again by turning the map.

Classes starting from Start 2 only use 1:7.500.

Terrain description

The terrain is very varied. From flat to rather hilly and in certain areas with many contour details. All areas have in common that the undergrowth is ample, mostly in the form of grass.

Runners starting from start 1 will cross an asphalt road with some traffic approximately halfway on the course. Be careful when crossing this road!

Mandatory routes

Mandatory routes are marked on the map and shall be followed.

Hedges and fences, which are not allowed to pass, are marked in purple. It is only allowed to pass these hedges and fences in openings or by passages constructed for this purpose. These options are indicated on the map as openings or by the signature for crossing points. In some of the fenced areas there will be sheep. In areas there will be electric fencing.

Out-of-bounds areas

Out-of-bounds areas are marked on the map and shall be respected.

Childrens course

The childrens courses this day are called "The Golden Round", "Super-sprint", "Red-white-blue" and "Tour of the Nordics". The courses are laid in the area around Seest Stadium with playground equipment and buildings. The courses are between 400 – 800 m long and on the controls we will meet WOC athletes and national flags. Maybe there is a picture of your favourite athlete? Prize: An autograph book where you can collect autographs from the WOC athletes.
