

Day 3 – 27. June Kolding

Driving directions

There are two parking options:

- Godset, Jens Holms Vej 9, 6000 Kolding. GPS-coordinates 55.491759, 9.485106 (WGS84 decimal)
- UC Syd, Dyrehavevej 116, 6000 Kolding. GPS-coordinates 55.498360, 9.475622 (WGS84 decimal)

There will be marking from parking to the arena.

Arena

The following services are available at the arena:

Changing rooms with showers are available near the arena. Follow the signs.

Distances and marking

- Parking Godset – arena, 1,3 km, or app. 15 min. walk.
- Parkering UC Syd – arena, 750 meter, or app. 10 min. walk.
- Arena – start 1, app. 250 meter, or app. 5 min. walk. Marked with pink flags.
- Arena – start 2, app. 650 meter, or app. 10 min. walk. Marked with light green flags.

Runners on their way to start 2 should be aware that they could meet other runners on their way to the last control. Please be considerate and step aside if necessary.

Classes, course lengths and number of controls

Race map

Kolding, scale 1:4.000 and 1:3.000. Contour interval 2,5 meter.

Age groups M60 og W60 og above use 1:3.000, others use 1:4.000.

Terrain description

The old part of town has an assymetric layout with town houses, shops, cafe- and restaurant areas, backyards and alleys. The surface is hard and in some places with cobble stones. Northwest of the old part of town there are small recreational parks and backyards with lawns and playgrounds, as well as condominiums. South and southwest of the old town is dominated by public buildings and schools as well as condominiums and office buildings. In the south runs Kolding River and a railroad running east-west.

Mandatory routes

Out-of-bounds areas

Out-of-bounds areas are marked on the maps by red hatching. In some areas there will be marking in the terrain to support identification of the boundary.

Safety

The roads in the town are not closed and some traffic must be expected. Follow the traffic regulations and be particularly aware when crossing roads, in particular in the north-western and western part of the area.

On the Children's course you will find and punch fairy tale controls. In the park north of the arena there are 5 different routes with pictures from fairy tales, which are all written by the Danish author Hans Christian Andersen. Can you find all the fairy tales? How many of them do you know? Fine prizes for all runners.
